

Curriculum Intent - KS4 Enrichment

Intent

We aim to provide a range of high quality activities /courses that are tailored to the specific needs of our pupils which builds character and promotes employability skills.

We aim to establish partnerships and links with outside agencies such as The Wildlife Trust , The Prince's Trust ,Burnley Football in the Community and local colleges in an attempt to inspire pupils to make positive choices both in school and in their future careers.

Implementation

Students will follow planned activities each term over 4 x 45min. sessions every Wednesday. The sessions work alongside awards such as Prince's Trust and The Duke of Edinburgh Schemes.

The lessons will be lead by Mrs D Hallam and a TA

Where possible all sessions will be off-site

At times pupils will remain on-site but have a less rigid timetable e.g

- tea, toast and conversation
- theory/self reflection
- practical activities/problem solving
- sport/teamwork/cookery

Impact

Although no formal data is recorded ,other than attendance, our enrichment programme will promote the life-skills needed for everyday life and develop the "**soft skills**" that employers and universities look for.

- Pupils build their social development through interaction with the wider community
- Pupils have the opportunity to work alongside outside agencies such as the Wildlife Trust and BFC
- Pupils develop numeracy/Literacy and communication skills through practical based activities
- Pupils develop confidence and resilience to complete tasks without 'giving up' or losing focus
