One	<p>Safety and security in construction</p> <p>Construction activities take place in many different contexts. Through this unit, learners will gain the knowledge and understanding to be able to plan how to minimise risk to their own and others health and safety in different contexts.</p> <p>Externally assessed examination.</p>
Two	<p>Practical construction skills</p> <p>Through this unit learners will be able to interpret technical information to plan the refurbishment of a building, taking account of health and safety issues.
