

Intervention

Intent

The aim of the intervention team is to support students by enabling them to engage in their learning. We also aim to develop the social and emotional skills of the students to identify how they can self-manage their behaviour and communicate their needs appropriately.

Implementation

The intervention team is based in the Learning Support Room; a new classroom designed in 2018. It offers a calming environment, where students can work independently or in small groups with a teaching assistant. They also have access to a library of books, computers and various resources within the room to help with their learning. Some of our students also access bespoke maths and English intervention sessions that are personalised to their specific needs and help plug gaps in their learning.

Along with completing work with the students that they have been unable to finish in class, we also offer a safe place where the students can discuss any concerns that they are experiencing. We can help them resolve their issues by either giving them a solution or showing them how they can use their own strategies to reach a resolution for themselves in the future.

Intended Impact

The Learning Support Room is seen as a safe place within school where students can leave a stressful situation and come to calm down. As a result of this they can then continue their day in an improved mood and complete their learning successfully. This supports the student in reaching their potential, as well as, supporting their classmates in being able to complete their learning.
