


School covid testing - reporting a lateral flow test result

What is this for? This guide shows school staff, students, households and support or childcare bubbles how to report the covid-19 lateral flow test result so that it is linked with the school.


Why does this matter? This helps Lancashire County Council to provide the Covid-19 support needed to keep our schools safe and open.
